The items on this school supply list are broken into two categories: “Items to Bring to School,” and “Items to be Left at Home.” If possible, please try to bring the “Items to Bring to School” with you on your first day of school, which is **Wednesday, September 7th**. Leave the “Items to be Left at Home” at home! Also, be sure to bring your summer assignment with you to school on the first day!

Items to Bring to School

Homeroom

- 3-hole punched looseleaf paper
- 1 ½ inch binder

- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Sharpie marker
- Pencil case

Spanish

- 3- or 5- subject notebook
- Pack of thin dry erase markers
- 1 sturdy 2-pocket folder

For General Use:

1 Flashdrive (minimum 1 Gigabyte) with string or keychain attached

Art (for the Classroom)

- 601/602: Paper towels
- 603/604: Facial tissues
- 605: Spray bottle of lemon scented all-purpose cleaner
- 606: Paper towels

Items to be Left at Home

For General Use:

- 12-pack colored pencils
- Post-it notes
- 3x5 index cards

Art (*Note: The art teacher will tell students when to bring these items to school—students should **not** bring any of these items to school until they are told to do so by their art teacher.*)

- a 9”x12” sketch book
- 1 Zippered 3 ring binder (because these binders are moved around a lot it is important that they have zippers to keep their contents from falling out)
- 10 sheet protectors
- 10 ziplock bags (gallon sized)
- A zippered pencil case containing: a 4GB usb drive
- One additional Zippered pencil case containing: 1pair of chopsticks, 1 butter knife, 2 large or 4 small gluesticks, 2 black sharpies, 2 pencils, 1 bottle of white out, and 1 box of paper fasteners.
