***What to bring:***

- On the first day, you will be eating lunch with your new classmates in the cafeteria. You may bring your lunch OR buy lunch in the cafeteria.
- Something to write on (paper or notebook) and something to write with (pencil or pen)! *You do not need to bring any other school supplies on the first day.*

At the end of the day, your homeroom teacher will take you downstairs to the main entrance at 2:10p.m., where you will meet your parent or guardian to go home.
